



Active ICC and Gender Sensitization Committees: The college boasts of a highly active Internal Complaints Committee constituted according to the provisions of the POSH Act to look into any possible complaints of sexual harassment on campus. 

Psychological Counselling Cell

A unique feature of the college is its highly functional Psychological Counselling Cell helmed by a trained counsellor to provide private counselling sessions to students in distress completely free of cost. The Cell also conducts workshops and awareness programmes on mental well being, stress management etc to sensitize students about mental health issues.






