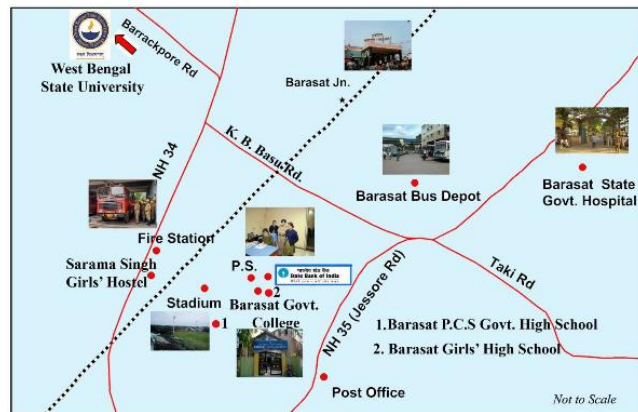


### Well-Connected Campus

**2.1.1 Plan of action for gender sensitization**

The members of the ICC decided that gender sensitization workshops need to be undertaken with students of every department in small groups to ensure active participation of all students. A notice was issued by the ICC requesting all departments to arrange a one day workshop with the students. Prof. Debagran Chakraborty, a member of the ICC, was requested to conduct the workshop. The following are the list of departments who responded to the request and date for set for the program as follows:

**GENDER SENSITIZATION ACTION PLAN**

**July 2022- June 2023**

Barasat Govt. College boasts of an active and vibrant Internal Complaints Committee functioning in the college since 2013. At present the committee consists of 10 members including teaching faculty, non-teaching staff and an external member who is a lawyer by profession working for the upholding of women's rights. ICC works in tandem with a Gender Sensitization Committee comprising of 5 members for promoting a culture of zero tolerance to sexual harassment and creating a safe campus where everyone irrespective of their gender and sexual identity are free to be who they are.

The activities planned by the committee are as follows:

- (1) ICC is a forum where students or employees can lodge complaints pertaining to any form of sexual harassment. To maintain ease and confidentiality of the complainant several means are to be provided for by ICC. Complaint Drop box, mail id, phone numbers of ICC members etc. are to be displayed both in the college lobby as well as the college website.
- (2) Gender sensitization programs are to be held throughout the year as a means of raising awareness on gender identity, LGBTQI rights, laws pertaining to women's rights, methods of seeking redressal etc. with the help of professionals and academicians working in this field. A program may be organized in December 2023 to commemorate activities against gender based violence.
- (3) Celebration of women's empowerment through cultural programs, poster competitions etc. involving students of the college is to be organized during the women's history month in March, 2023.
- (4) ICC and gender cell is to organize regular, intimate workshops on gender sensitization with students of each department with the help of ICC members to generate awareness on issues of consent and harassment through the use of film clips, scenarios of specific situations and anecdotes, popular memes etc. so that students are able to relate easily with the issues.

**GENDER SENSITIZATION ACTION PLAN**

**June 2023- July 2024**

Barasat Govt. College boasts of an active and vibrant Internal Complaints Committee functioning in the college since 2013. At present the committee consists of 10 members including teaching faculty, non-teaching staff and an external member who is a lawyer by profession working for the upholding of women's rights. This new committee has been formed on 16.01.2023 incorporating new members in place of teachers and staff who have either retired or have been transferred from the institution. ICC works in tandem with a Gender Sensitization Committee comprising of 4 members for promoting a culture of zero tolerance to sexual harassment and creating a safe campus where everyone irrespective of their gender and sexual identity are free to be who they are.

The activities planned by the committee are as follows:

- (1) To maintain ease and confidentiality of complainant the mail id and phone numbers of ICC members etc. are displayed both in the college lobby as well as the college website.
- (2) Gender sensitization programs are to be held throughout the year as a means of raising awareness on gender identity, LGBTQI rights, laws pertaining to women's rights, methods of seeking redressal etc.
- (3) Celebration of women's empowerment through cultural programs, poster competitions etc.
- (4) Organizing regular, intimate workshops on gender sensitization with students of each department with the help of ICC members to generate awareness on issues of consent and harassment through the use of film clips, scenarios of specific situations and anecdotes, popular memes etc. so that the issues become easily relatable for students.
- (5) Mural paintings on walls of the college foyer to raise awareness of gender issues.
- (6) Launching an e-magazine on gender issues with poems, sketches, writings etc. from students.
- (7) Collaboration with other women's rights organizations to help organize art workshops, film shows etc. on gender issues.
- (8) Creating an ICC member cell volunteers group from members from the student community to help in organizing the various sensitization programs so that they in turn can sensitize others of their community.

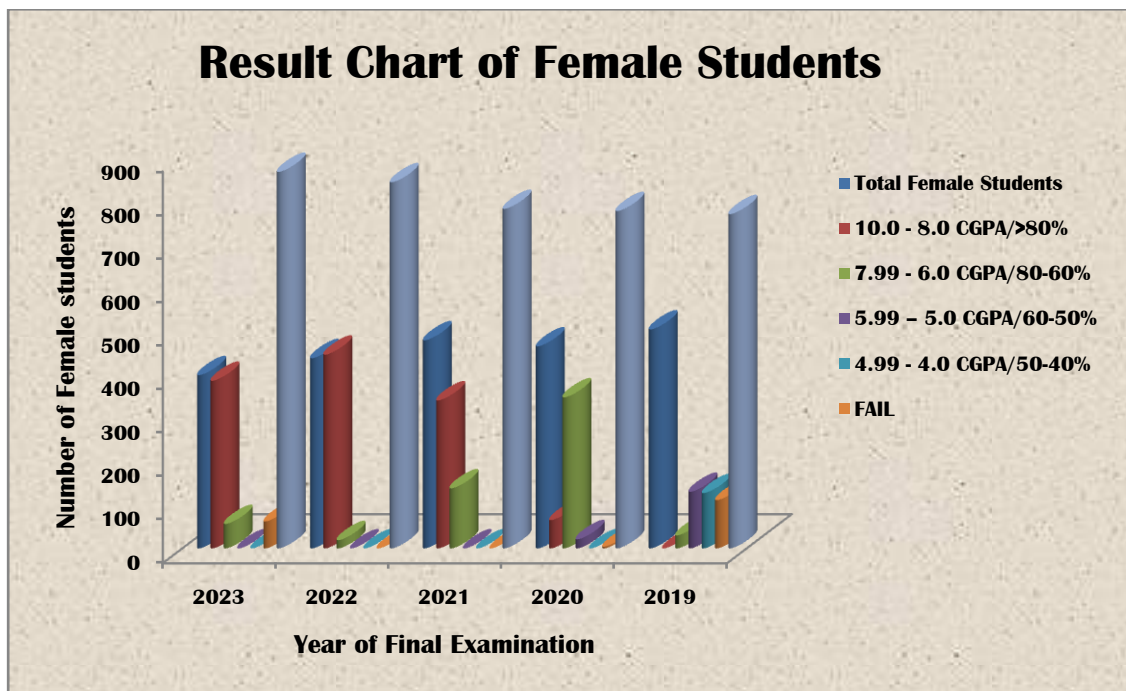

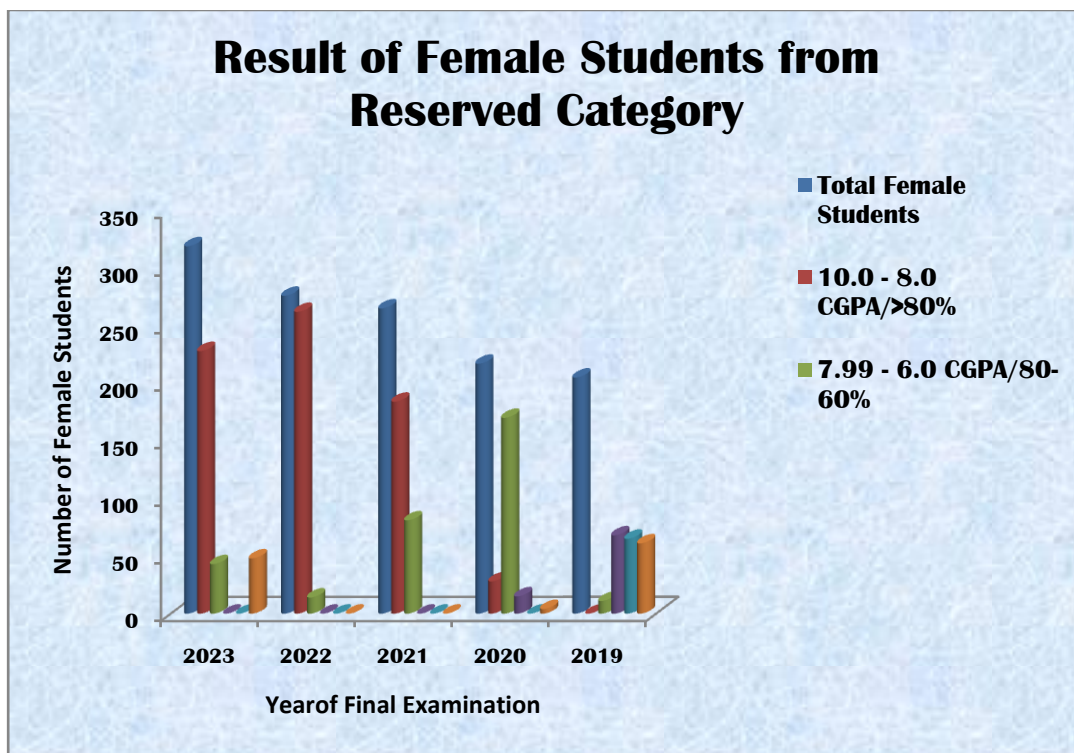

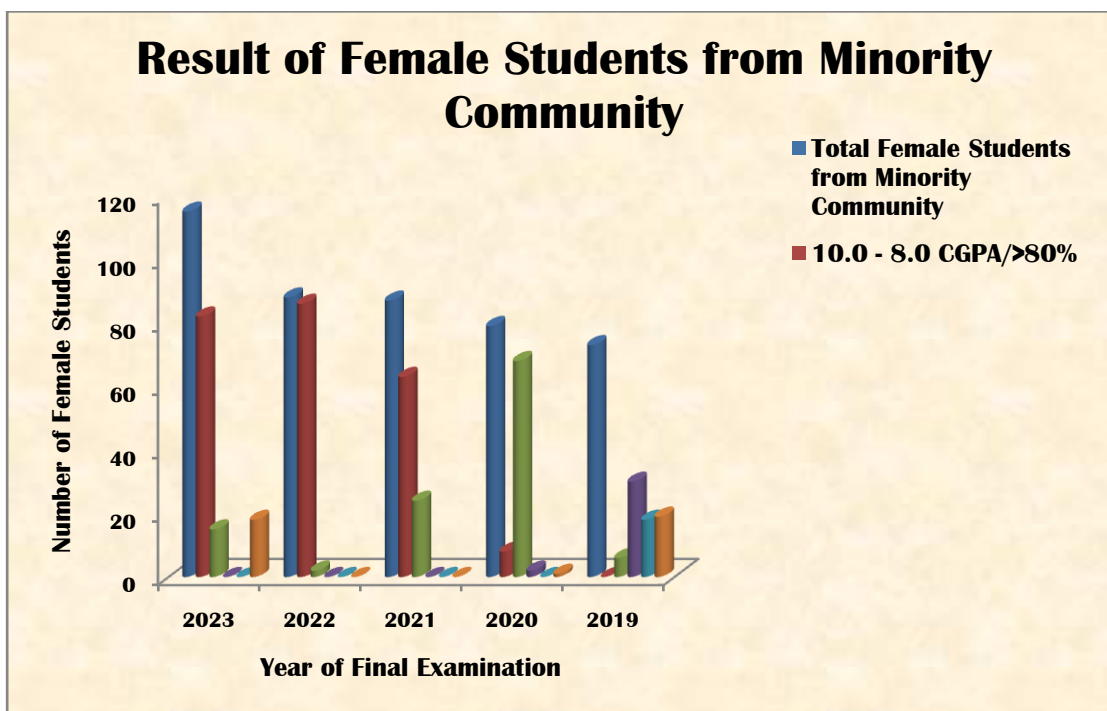
